Non Combustible Concrete Mantel



In the Box

- Renostone Mantel
- Mounting Bracket

Tools Required (not provided)

- Electric Drill/Driver
- Screw Drivers/Bits
- Level
- Tape Measure
- Stud Finder
- Pen, Pencil or Marker
- Self-Tapping Screw
- Lag bolt

Optional (not provided)

• Construction Adhesive



Installation Notes

- It is recommended that two people are available to lift and install the mantel.
- Bracket must be installed into wall studs.
- If you are unable to find studs, you need to open the wall and add wood or metal studs.
- It is recommended to utilize a minimum of three studs for 4' & 5' mantels
- It is recommended to utilize a minimum of four studs for 6' mantels.

Installation Instructions

- 1. Locate and mark stud locations, install studs if required.
- 2. Unpack mantel & mounting bracket
- 3. Mark the center of the mantel location on the wall
- 4. Determine the desired height for the mantel, draw a horizontal line
- 5. Center mounting bracket, mark stud locations on bracket
- 6. Using a 3/16 drill bit, drill two 3/16 holes in mounting bracket per marked stud locations
- 7. Secure mounting bracket to studs using lag bolts, start in center, checking for level
- 8. Dry fit the mantel on the bracket and check for level, adjust bracket if necessary
- With the mantel in place, centered over the mounting bracket, confirm the location by marking one end of mantel on the wall with a pencil Optional: Apply construction adhesive on the back of the mantel to secure against the wall.
- 10. Enjoy the beauty of your new non-combustible mantel!



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
